Romans 3: Paul's Apostleship and the Glory of God

- 1. In Rom. 1, God announces Paul's distinctive Apostleship and gives 2 patterns:
 - a. God's way to Righteousness and Life based on the Pattern of Paul's Ministry. 1:1-17
 - b. Man's way to Sin and Death based on the Pattern of Fallen Humanity. 1:18-32
- 2. In Rom. 2, explains that no one, Jew and Gentile alike, can escape God's Wrath by holding as having no value/despising the Riches of God now being dispensed through Paul's Apostleship. Rather they just grow richer in Wrath for the Day of Wrath.
- 3. Rom. 3 opens by explaining that no one, especially the Jew, can escape God's wrath by "attacking the messenger," attacking the Apostleship of Paul. It just proves that their condemnation is just.
- 4. In conclusion, God concludes all under sin.
 - a. Rom. 11:32—the why—so that He can show mercy to all.
 - b. Gal. 3:22—that the promise by faith of Christ Jesus might be given to them who believe.
