
Inspiration

- II Timothy 3:16 = God-breathed
- Use of personalities and backgrounds = Luke,
 Paul, etc.
- Sometimes dictation
- Other times "moved" by the Holy Spirit
- Extends to the very words, tense of verbs, singular vs. plural, etc.
- Original documents, copies

Inspiration Preservation

Preservation

- Psalm 12:6-7
- Psalm 119:89
- Isaiah 40:8
- Matthew 24:35
- The warning of Revelation 22:18-19
- Preservation includes translations, but is bigger than that



Translation

- Inspiration and Preservation are 100% of God
- Translation is the effort of man to put God's
 Word into a variety of languages about 700
- Best manuscripts are a combination of the Majority Text and the Received Text (Textus Receptus)...refer to Steve Walker's messages on "Why I'm not KJO"
- We use the KJV because it is translated from the best manuscripts

Translation

Some key questions that require an answer:

- Are the 699 translations into other languages free from error?
- Was there an English translation that was free from error prior to 1611?
- Should grace believers, who follow the Biblical instruction to study the Word of God rightly divided, break fellowship and divide over the KIV?

Translation

The KJ translators were keenly aware of the fact that they could have done a better job, and never claimed to have produced an inerrant translation

I can have wonderful fellowship, and have had, with anyone who believes that the KJV is without error

Unfortunately, many KJO zealots cannot

Interpretation/Proclamation

The proclamation, or teaching of God's Word must follow God's instructions in 2 Timothy 2:15 BUT, all instruction, must be examined and tested, and not blindly accepted as accurate While following God's instructions for study, and proclamation, and relying upon the Holy Spirit to illuminate our understanding, we do not proclaim the Word of God without error

Interpretation/Proclamation

- Interestingly, and quite amazingly, God uses the personality, background, and style of the teacher...even as in Inspiration
- We must never be distracted from the rich proclamation of God's Word by the personality, or style of the teacher...you're robbing yourself!
