## The Great Revelation: God is Real, but why so unpopular?

PART 3

Three undeniable proofs of the existence of God

- 1. The Bible *assumes* the existence of God Gen. 1:1
- 2. Fulfilled prophecy
- 3. God has provided man with proof Ro. 1:19-20
  a) *Conscience*
  - b) Creation screams out loudly that God exists!
    - Tells of His infinite power inherent in Him

How is it then, that with such clear and universal evidence, people don't believe in God?

## Something horrible happened!

- Two very important things to be aware of:
- a) God does not IMPOSE Himself on us, but EXPOSES us to what is true
- b) We therefore have choices, but no choice as to the CONSEQUENCES of our choices...the principle of Galatians 6:7 – Sowing and reaping

- 5 Choices in Romans 1, and many Consequences:
- 1) <u>The Choice:</u> Suppressing God's truth in favor of unrighteousness Ro. 1:18
  - The Consequence: Man is without excuse 1:19-20

- 2) <u>The Choice:</u> They did not glorify Him as God, neither were thankful – Ro. 1:21a
- <u>The Consequences:</u> a) They became vain in their imaginations, b) were thrust into complete spiritual darkness, c) professing themselves to be wise, they became fools – Ro. 1:21b-22

3) <u>The Choice:</u> Man exchanged the glory of the uncorruptible God and replaced it with manmade images and idols – Ro. 1:23

<u>The Consequences:</u> God gives man up and turns him over to act in all sorts of moral impurity – Ro. 1:24

4. <u>The Choice:</u> Man exchanged the truth of God for a lie and chose to worship and serve the creature rather than the Creator – Ro. 1:25

<u>The Consequence:</u> God gives man up to vile, evil, shameful affections, including the unnatural activities of men with men, and womes with women – Ro. 1:26-27

5. <u>The Choice:</u> Men did not like to retain God in their knowledge (pushing Him out of their consciousness) – Ro. 1:28a

<u>The Consequences:</u> God gives man over to a reprobate/rejected/base mind – Ro. 1:28b-32

- How did this world get this bad? Genesis 3-11!!
- Genesis 3: Man chose to disobey God, sin is introduced into the human race, power struggle was introduced in marriage, and all man could produce was sinners
- Genesis 4: There was a tragic disruption to the family, brother against brother, Cain killed Abel

- Genesis 6: Things regressed so badly that the whole human race was corrupted, and God had to bring judgement – The flood
- Genesis 11: What we've been studying in Romans 1 And that's how this world, and its inhabitants, got so bad!!
