Israel's Prophetic Program Set Aside

A

- 1. Ephesians picks up where Romans left off:
  - a. The mechanics of the Mystery—God's change in Programs
     —in Romans becomes the purpose of the Mystery in Ephesians.
  - b. Romans ends with being filled with all gnosis (Rom. 15:14
     —partial knowledge). Ephesians begins with being filled with all epi-gnosis (Eph. 1:17—full-acknowledgement).
  - c. All the blessings Romans 8 closes with, Eph. picks up with in review and moves them from things for us to things for God (Eph. 1:3-14).

- d. God's Prophetic Program with Israel that was diminishing in Romans has completely ceased and off-stage in Ephesians.
- e. The foundation Paul laid in Romans, the Body of Christ's as the household of God is built upon in Ephesians (Eph. 2:19 -22).
- f. The one mind and one mouth of Romans (Rom. 15:6) is centered on the unity of the Spirit in Ephesians (Eph. 4:3-5).
- g. The bruising of Satan under the believer's feet in Romans with partial armor becomes a full-fledged seating-together with Christ above all powers in the power of His might in the full armor of God to withstand all the wiles of the devil (Eph. 1:19-21; 6:11).

- h. The "grace of our Lord Jesus Christ to you all (Rom. 16:24) becomes the "riches and glory of His grace" to you all (Eph. 1:6 -7; 2:7).
- i. God's power in Romans (Rom. 16:25) becomes the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe and His mighty power in Ephesians (Eph. 1:19).
- j. The revelation of God's Mystery to the Romans (rom. 16:25-26) has gone out to all people in Ephesians (Eph. 3:8-9).
- k. The two aspects of Rom. 16:26: Paul's apostolic ministry by personal visits (Rom. 1:10-11; 15:24) gives way to Paul's apostolic ministry by Paul's Scriptures in Ephesians (Eph. 1:12 -13; 3:2-4; Col. 2:1, 4:16).
- I. Romans emphasized the GOSPEL that consists of the Mystery, Ephesians emphasizes the MYSTERY that consists of the Gospel.

2. Some suggest a general order to Paul's Epistles based on 2 Tim. 3:16-17:

All Scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

#### 3. The terms:

- a. Doctrine/Instruction—that which is taught from God's Word—teaching, instruction—today PGMT.
- b. Reproof—rebuking someone who has done wrong that carries conviction through God's doctrine.
- c. Correction—return or restore to a right position by God's doctrine.

- 4. This is an excellent teaching tool but as with everything, it shouldn't be taken too far. Certainly, there is much correction and reproof in Romans and Ephesians and much doctrine and instruction in Corinthians, Galatians, Philippians and Colossians.
  - -- It is a general tool not an absolute tool.
