


In Christ In Action Eph. 1:3

1. In the sphere of Christ: U.P.I.I. (up/e/i, like denarii—den/ar/e/i):

- a. U: Believers are UNITED with Christ ... (6:5-10)
- b. P: Believers are made PARITICIPANTS in all Christ did for them (6:4)
- c. I: Believers are INDENTIFIED them so closely to Christ that what is true of Christ is also true of them (Rom. 5:15-19; 6:3).
- d. I: Believers are INCORPORATED into Christ as members of His Body, the Body of Christ, joined to their Head, the Lord Jesus Christ, and to every other believer, in a new redeemed and righteous humanity, knit together in Love. (Rom. 8:1; 12:5; Eph. 4:15-16; Col. 2:2).

- 2. IN CHRIST in Ephesians:
 - a. Where believers receive and participate in His grace and peace (Eph. 1:1-2). (Incorporation)
 - b. Where the Father blesses us with all spiritual blessings in the Heavenlies (1:3). (Identification, Participation)
 - c. In God's loved One (In Christ), we are accepted, favored by God, redeemed and set free from anything against us (1:6-7)
 - d. In Christ we have obtained an inheritance (1:11; co-heirs with Christ, heirs of God—Rom. 8). (United, Participants)
 - e. Where God placed us to raise us up together with Christ and seat us in the Heavenlies together with Christ (2:6). (United, Identified, Participate).

- f. Where God incorporated Us into a new humanity so that we could participate in His good works devised in eternity past (2:10).
- g. Where God placed us when He brought us near to Himself and to each other by His blood (2:13). (United to Christ and through Christ God and all other believers.)
- h. Where God makes us participants in His promise (3:6). (Union, Participants, Incorporation.)
- i. Where God makes us participants and fulfills all His purpose (3:10-11).
 - --God's ultimate purpose centers on Christ and those IN CHRIST are incorporated into His Body where they are made participants in God's purpose.

- 3. IN CHRIST outside Ephesians:
 - a. In Christ, God makes us a new creation, reconciled and the righteousness of God (2 Cor. 5:17, 19, 21; Gal. 6:14-15).
 - b. In Christ, we are the adult children of God, adult sons and daughters, and like THE SON, we can participate in the Father's business accessing the Father's riches. (Gal. 3:26-27).
 - c. In Christ, we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins (Rom. 3:24).
 - d. In Christ, we are freed from the principle of sin and death (Rom. 8:2).

- e. In Christ, we are permanently joined to the Love of God (Rom. 8:39).
- f. In Christ, God makes us one body (Rom. 12:5).
- g. In Christ, should regulate everything we say (Rom. 9:1) and do (Rom. 16:10).
- h. In Christ God sets us apart for His Own plan and purpose (1 Cor. 1:2).
- i. In Christ, our whole Christian life centers on Him whom God has made unto us wisdom, righteousness, sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30).

- j. In Christ, we are begotten through the Gospel (1 Cor. 4:15).
- k. In Christ, we operate by remembering Paul's teaching (1 Cor. 4:17).
- In Christ, we are established (2 Cor. 1:21), and have victory and triumph as we make known His knowledge everywhere (2 Cor.2:14).
- m. In Christ, we are freed to serve and enjoy God (Gal. 2:4)
- n. In Christ, all worldly differences vanish—we are all one (Gal. 3:28).
