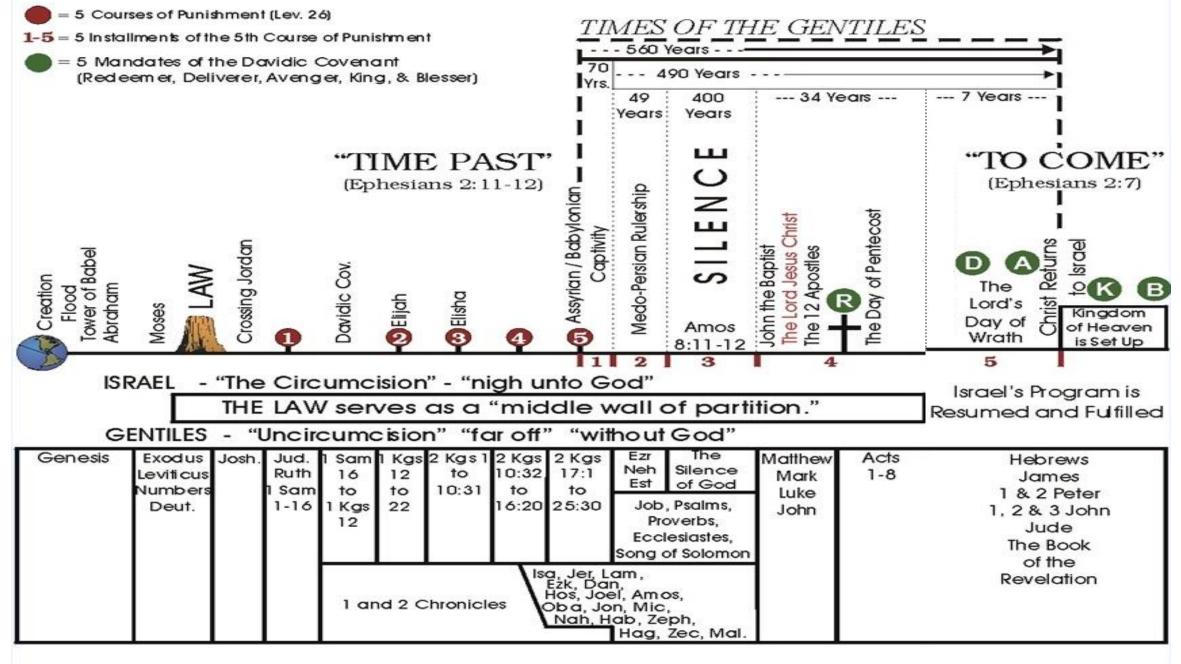


Satan and the Secret Pt. 4

Ephesians 1:9-10; 1 Cor. 2:7-8;

Israel and the disciples not only could but SHOULD have known about the death of Christ because of Daniel's Time Schedule the 69th week was closing, at within a brief period of time the 70th week would be completed, Christ would return and establish the Kingdom.

- a. JohnB knew because he came announcing that the Kingdom was at hand, the Gospel of the Kingdom (Mat. 3:2), which, according to Daniel, would come after the death of Christ.
- b. Jesus was announcing the same thing (Mat. 4:17, 23).

- a. This announcing the time (Daniel's Time) is fulfilled, Kingdom is at hand, repent and believe to enter into it (Mk. 1:14-15).
- A bunch of Gentile wisemen from Babylon knew by combining Balaam's star prophecy with Daniel's Time Schedule—which only referred to the death of Messiah and they worked backward from that (Mat. 2:1-2).
- c. Jerusalem and Israel should have known the time of their visitation but didn't. Like the disciples, they could and should have known but it was hid from them: NOT BY GOD AND JESUS but by Satan and the VRS (Lk. 19:41-44).

- Last time we saw there are two basic ways God's Word about the death and resurrection of Christ in relation to the Nation of Israel can be treated:
 - a. Someone can know and understand it by receiving it in faith, bringing it into their hearts and letting it shape their minds, guide their actions, and operate in accord with it.
 - b. If someone doesn't know or understand it, it's because they have rejected it in unbelief, leaving their hearts darkened and ruling it out of their minds, thinking they can change and nullify it, bringing God's plan to nothing either willfully Satan) or ignorantly (Peter).

- 2. If humans could know about it through God's revelation of it in the OT and Jesus's teaching of it in the Gospels, Satan could know it as well.
 - a. He knew about it, understood it, and plotted his course of action—ascending, ascending, ascending--thinking he could subvert and nullify God's plan for reclaiming the earthly realm unto His Glory by trying to:
 - --Keep Christ from dying AT THE RIGHT TIME—as revealed in the OT, esp. Daniel's Time Schedule (Dan. 9:25-26; Mat. 2:16; 4:5-7).

- --And/or keep Christ from being put to death IN THE RIGHT WAY (Mat. 2:16; 4:5-7; Lk. 4:29-30)—as revealed esp. in the Gospel Accounts—on the Cross (also Deut. 21:23; Gal. 3:13; Zech. 12:10).
- b. Or, try to obviate the need for the Cross and death altogether (Mat. 4:8-11; Mat. 28:18—after His death and resurrection; Mat. 16:21-23)
- c. Just as in the Garden of Eden, Satan took God's revealed word, and hid it in his deceptions, twisting and perverting it, vainly imagining that he could thwart God's I AM/I WILL Jehovah Name plan and accomplish his own i am/i will plan (Is. 14).

- 3. Christ had to die according to God's Prophetic plan, which goes through the Cross, or He would not have been raised up again and Satan would have succeeded in bruising the Seed of the woman's head rather than just its heal/foot. Satan "knew" of this plan and tried to thwart its happening.
 - a. First, trying to blot out the royal Judah/Davidic line through which the seed of the woman would come, who would crush the head of the serpent. In God's plan for the death (crushing/bruising) of the seed of the woman, the Davidic Messiah, it would only be a crushing of the heel for He would raise Him from the dead, fulfilling Gen. 3:15.

- b. Then, in Christ's earthly ministry, Satan worked to put Him to death in the wrong way or at the wrong time (Mat. 2:16; Lk. 4:29-30).
 - --The Davidic Messiah had to die in a certain way to benefit Israel—hanged on a "tree," so that through a technicality of the Law He could fall under its curses (Deut. 21:22-23), taking onto Himself all the astronomical accumulation of the curses of the Law that the fell upon the Nation of Israel, paying off the debt in full, redeeming them so He could make them into His Own debt-free nation through which He will repossess the Earth from Satan (Gal. 3:13; Zech. 12:10; 13:6; Act 1:11).
 - --He also had to die at a certain time—it had to be in accord with the Father's plan as revealed in Daniel's Time Schedule (Dan. 9:26).


- 4. When these efforts failed, and he couldn't stop Christ's prophetic death on the tree/Cross, he went full steam ahead (Lk. 22:3) to battle Jesus Christ on the Cross (Is. 50:4-8), thinking that as Jesus suffered the extreme physical, emotional and spiritual weakness on the Cross, that he could prevent Him from entering his house and spoiling it (Mk. 3:23-27). He thought he could drag Him down into the pit of death and close the gates of Hell over Him to see corruption, bringing God's plan to nothing (Ps. 16:10; 116:3-9; Acts 2:24, 27, 31).
 - --But Satan wasn't victorious and God raised Christ from the dead and seated Him at His right hand, having accomplished the all that God set out to do.


- 5. But Satan failed in bringing God's plan to re-establish His Glory on the Earth through the Nation of Israel to nothing.
 - --(AD 33-34)--Peter proclaimed to the earthly rulers and the heavenly rulers behind them that unlike all other sons of David, God raised this Son of David from the dead! And now He is just waiting to return to destroy His enemies and save His friends and sit on David's throne in reclaimed Jerusalem ruling reclaimed humanity and the reclaimed Earth through reclaimed Israel (Acts 2:22-36; 3:19-26).

- 6. Peter's preaching of Satan's defeat and God's repossession of the Earth in accord with the Abrahamic Covenant (Acts 3:19-26) from Satan clutches as usurper, would have made Satan mad, but he could console himself with the thought that he still retained control of the Heavenly realm.
 - --He could still negatively influence the Earthly realm toward rebellion against God and rejection of His Word, thinking he might win it back some day.
