Creation and Our Inheritance

Ephesians 1:11-12

1. Ephesians explains that God exalted the Lord Jesus Christ's as resurrected Man into the heavenlies FAR above all the governmental rulers of Satan's evil empire, catching them in their own trap.
 - a. And Christ took us, the Body of Christ, with Him.
 - b. He is going to use us to fill the vacant positions that will exist when He once-and-for-all removed Satan and all his cohorts from their rulership positions. He will replace them with the Body of Christ (Eph. 1:20-21)

- c. Therefore, every time Satan and his cohorts see one of their empire, an ungodly sinner on enemy status, saved and operating in accord with God and His plan...it reminds them that they were caught in their own deceptions and their complete destruction is coming. God has re-claimed His human creation from Satan.
- d. God left us down here on earth for the sole job of boldly proclaiming the Mystery of the Gospel, which powerfully takes people, things, moments of time and territory away from Satan and reclaims them for God and His Glory (Eph. 6:10-20), displaying His manifold wisdom and exceedingly great Riches of Grace (Eph. 1:7; 3:9).
- e. The fact that the Mystery is virtually unknown to most of Christianity is a testament to how successful Satan has been in hindering God's plan.

2. The Cross provided basis for re-centering the whole Creation IN_CHRIST—removing sins, victorious over death, freeing from Satan—which Christ rules, placing it under through 2 IN-CHRIST groups of redeemed humanity—The Nation of Israel on Earth and the Body of Christ in the Heavens—who willingly and freely belong to God through Christ.
 - a. God the Father delights in the wisdom and knowledge of this plan centered on His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ (Col. 2:2-3).
 - b. He wants to share that delight and joy with His new creation of redeemed humanity, a new humanity reclaimed from Satan and made His Own, who will enjoy it all together with Him in perpetual fellowship and communion, FOREVERMORE (Eph. 1:11-12, 18).

3. God created the universe by wisdom, understanding, knowledge, and His Wisdom dwells with prudence (Prov. 3:19-21; 8:12).
 - a. Like a human builder of a house, God had a plan, a blueprint, already in place when He began building, constructing the house of the universe (Job 38:4-7; Amos 9:6).
 - b. And His construction was good (Gen. 1:4, 10, 12, 18, 21, 25, 31) because it was in perfect accord with His wise plan.
 - c. Everything “good” operated in accord with God. Everything that doesn’t operate in accord with God is “evil,” bad.

- d. When Adam and Eve ate of the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil, they declared their independence from God and His plan (Gen. 2:17; 3:5-6, 22—last mention of the word “good” until Genesis 15:15 in reference to Abraham’s long life).
 - They would determine what was “good” not by evaluating it next to God’s plan but next to their own selfish plan in accord with their lusts of their flesh (Gen. 3:6-7).
 - They died spiritually immediately (Gen. 3:7-13), and they died physically in the future (Gen. 5).
4. God created the universe to be inhabited by Himself and His created intelligent beings, who could understand and appreciate His wisdom and power, and freely worship and praise and thankful fellowship with Him there (Gen. 1-2; Is. 45:18-19).

5. There was a contest between God and Satan over wisdom and prudence. Who was the rightful Possessor of Heaven and Earth (Gen. 14:19), and God won hands down by keeping the Mystery a secret until He revealed it to the Apostle Paul (Eph. 3:1-11).
 - a. The Mystery explains that the Cross was not only the way God would re-claim the Earth from vanity unto His Glory through the redeemed Nation of Israel; it was also the way He would re-claim the Heavens unto His Glory through the redeemed humanity of the Body of Christ (Rom. 16:25; Eph. 3:1-11).

b. Through the Cross, the Lord Jesus Christ will return to being the center and focus of both the Heavenly and the Earthly realms, which God announced in the Mystery: God raised Christ from the dead, raising Him above all human powers in the earthly realm and far above the angelic realm of principality/ies, power/s, might/s, dominion/s and every name, seating Him at His own right (Eph. 1:21; Col. 1:16).
