Ephesians 1:13-14

He Delights in Us

Tying up loose ends (Eph. 1:12-14):

a. v. 12—we (Paul and the Ephesians present at his visit in person some 7-9 years before) and ye (those who believed through word of mouth or Paul's Scriptures after he left Ephesus—see Col. 2:1; Rom. 16:26).

--This is the lesson God taught Paul in Romans. God is going to rely less and less on Paul's personal visits and more and more on his prophetic Scriptures to spread the Gospel (Rom. 1:11 contrast with Rom. 16:26).

--As Paul's Scriptures are recorded and completely and permanently distributed throughout the world, God will rely less and less on the partial and temporary spiritual gifts (rom. 12:3-8).



b. v. 13-14—after they heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation and believed you were sealed with the Holy Spirit, who guarantees your preservation throughout all time and eternity, giving you hope/trust that you will be full participants in His Glory via our sonship position in Christ when you receive your glorified body like unto His (Rom. 10:17).

--Redemption—setting free from our present mortal bodies under corruption with a body like unto His glorious, spiritual, heavenly body perfectly equipped for service esp. in the heavenly realm (Rom. 8:23-25; 1 Cor. 6:15, 19-20; 15:48-53; Phil. 3:20-21).

1. Redemption in Ephesians stresses that Christ's death frees us from everything that was against us so that God could work in and through us for the display of the riches of the Glory of His Grace (Eph. 1:6), not just before humans but before the supernatural powers in the spiritual heavenly realm as well (Eph. 3:9-10).
  - a. He takes pleasure, He delights, in making us (ungodly sinners on enemy status before Him, idolatrous Gentiles) the displayers of His Glory.
  - b. This is not just for the everlasting future (Eph. 2:7) but for right now as well (3:9).
    - Hopefully this is changing your viewpoint about everything!

2. God's eternal plan is to take those whose only title is sinner and give them the title of adult sons/daughters of God in Christ (1:5; Rom. 8:14-15; Gal. 4:6-7).

a. This is not a toddler saying da da ....

b. This is an adult son/daughter of God who recognizes the superiority of the Father's will and plan, and pursues it with single-minded determination and devotion, following it.

c. The perfect example is the Lord Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Mk. 14:36).

d. The key to operating according to our sonship position:

Not my will, but **THY** will.

3. Unlike Israel of old (Rom. 9:4), we do not need to wait to receive our sonship position, we have obtained it already (Eph. 1:11; Rom. 8:14-15; Gal. 4:6-7).
  - a. We are not waiting to be seated in an earthly land. We are already seated in the Heavenly “land” (Eph. 2:4-7).
  - b. We aren’t waiting for an earthly Kingdom. We have already been translated into the heavenly spiritual Kingdom of His dear Son (Col. 1:12-14).
  - c. We aren’t waiting for the Spirit to cry out Abba, Father. We already have the Spirit that frees us from bondage of fear and causes us to cry out Abba, Father as the Son (Mk. 14:36).
  - d. Our hope looks forward to when we can enjoy it fully without any hindrance in new bodies made like unto His glorious body either through the Resurrection or the Rapture (Eph. 1:14; Rom. 8:23; Phil. 3:20-21).

4. The Holy Spirit brings us into our sonship position, giving us access to God's riches and the instruction manual for how to use them, by indwelling and sealing us, guaranteeing our future (1:14).
5. Where Israel's inheritance was conditional under the law according to the flesh, ours is unconditional under Pauline grace according to the S/spirit.
  - a. Num. 14:8—If the LORD delight in us, then He will give us our inheritance. Moses said this to the 1<sup>st</sup> generation of whom only 2 were allowed to enter the land. Even Moses wasn't allowed!
  - b. Eph. 1:13-14; Rom. 8:15—The LORD delights in what He has done with us in Christ, therefore He has given us the Spirit of adoption--sonship.
