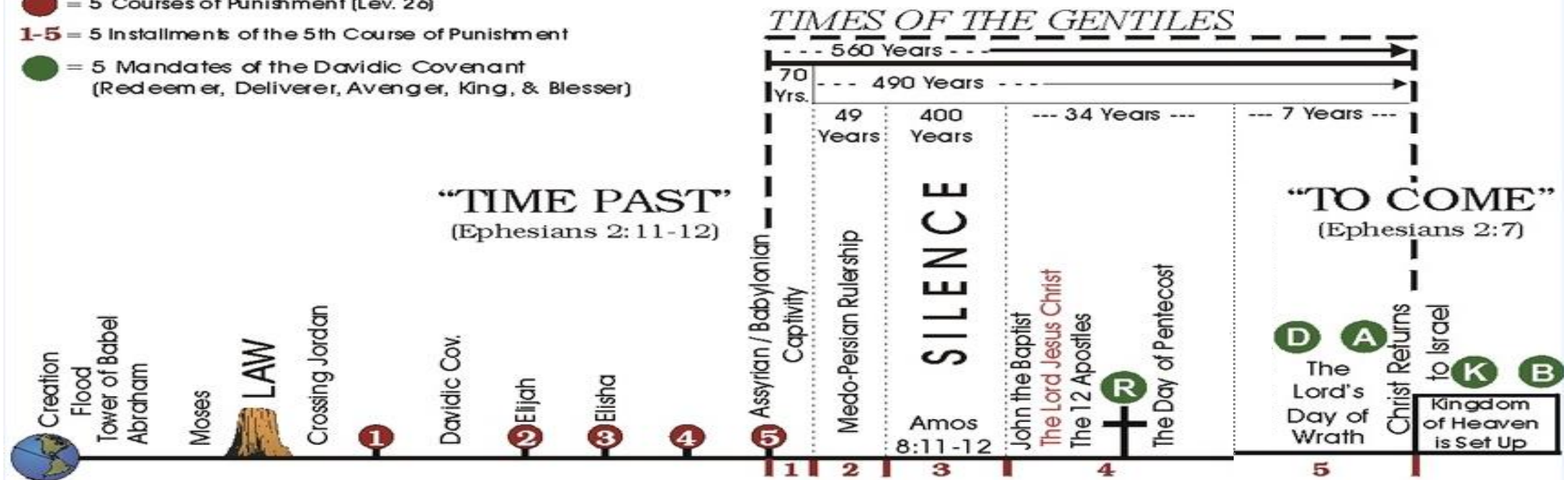

Ephesians 1:15-23

The Hope Of His Calling

1. In this prayer Paul prays that we might fully know Him and understand what He is doing. Then he answers his prayer request by instructing us in what He wants us to know:
 - a. What is the hope of God's calling, which will give us the understanding of:
 - b. What is riches of the Glory of His inheritance in the saints, ie., US! Which will bring us into an appreciation of:
 - c. What is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us already displayed when He powerfully re-organized the universe, reclaiming it unto His Own Glory under His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, subjecting the old creation under His feet and placing His new creation under His Head, filling us, the Body of Christ, with all His fullness.

2. To operate according to our adult sonship position, we need to understand and appreciate these things, God powerfully called us into His service, making us into the displayers of His Glory (1:6, 12, 14; Eph. 2:8-10; 2 Cor. 5:14-21).
 - a. As the recipients of the riches of His Grace, we become the displayers, reflectors, radiators of all that is true about His Grace, that is—we display the riches of the Glory of His Grace.
 - b. This is the good pleasure of His will—God, acting in Love, displaying the will of His grace, taking sinners and overflowing the riches of His mercy and goodness and kindness upon them.

- c. God delighting in us, causes us to delight in Him. When we delight in His Grace, we reflect that Grace to others. When we delight in His Mercy, we radiate that Mercy to others.
--When we delight in His Glory, we reflect it to others.
- d. This is the ultimate goal of creation, and we can begin NOW.
- e. This is the Hope of our Calling.

3. This IS sanctification, set apart for His purpose--holy (Eph. 1:4).
 - a. We reflect what our soul is occupied with--Christ.
 - b. First, we behold the Glory of the Lord the Father in the face of the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, in PGMT, which the Lord the Holy Spirit who indwells us, uses to transform us into His image by faith, by which we fulfil our creaturely purpose of being His image bearers as the reflectors of His Glory, revealing to others who and what He is (Rom. 12:2; 8:29; 2 Cor. 3:17-18; 4:6).
 - c. Therefore, He delights in us as He does in His Son (Eph. 1:6).
4. By being the object of His delight, He fills us with the infinite ocean of His Love, Grace, Kindness, Goodness, etc.,--His beloved ones--in the inner person, which He in turn draws from to empower our Christian walk.
