

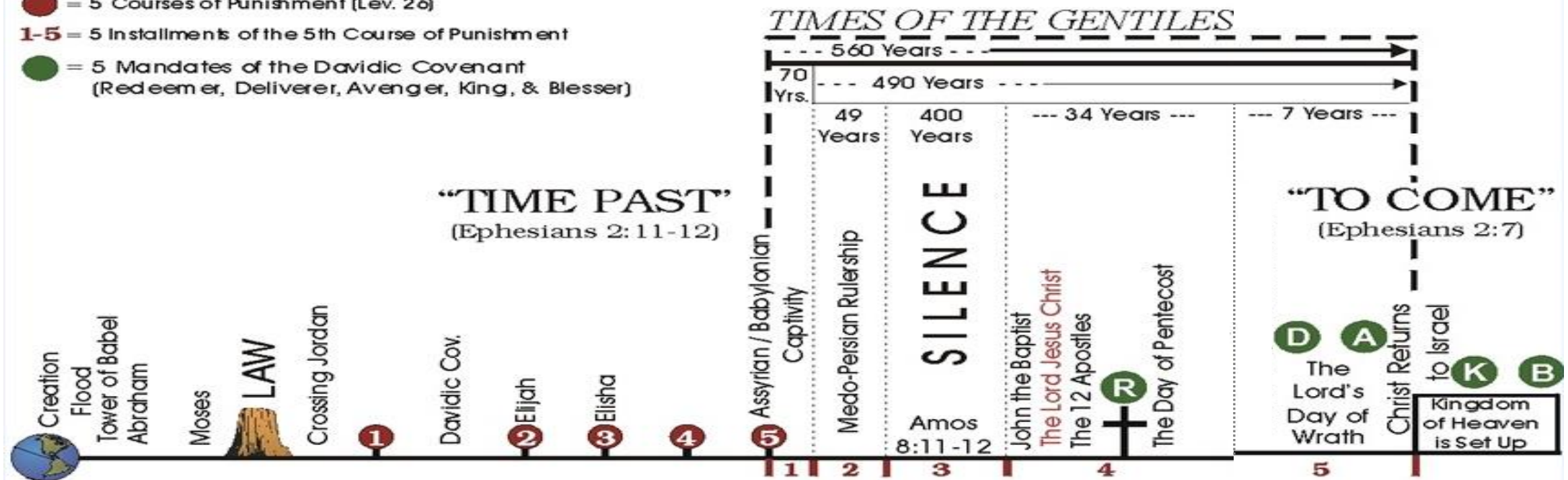

Eyes Enlightened

Review: The four links in the chain of victorious Christian living:
Paul prays that God would give:

1. Our spirit His Wisdom
2. And (even) the Holy Spirit's Revelation (of the Mystery) (Eph. 1:8-9),
3. Which will bring us into the full and complete knowledge of God—who He is and what He is doing to restore Creation unto His Glory, centered in Christ.
4. Which will enlighten our mind's eyes, our inner being.

1. **The eyes of our understanding being enlightened**—How does this happen? When we read Paul's Scriptures in faith, the Holy Spirit reveals and teaches the Revelation of the Mystery to us, filling our spirit with God's wisdom (Eph. 3:5; 6:17; 1 Cor. 2:10-11).
 - a. We, in turn, reveal it to not only humans in the earthly realm, but the powers in the heavenly realm as well (Eph.. 3:1-5, 10).
 - b. For the hostile heavenly powers, the Mystery is the declaration of their complete, certain and humiliating defeat—God took Satan in his own craftiness (1 Cor. 3:19; Eph. 4:8-10; Col. 2:15).

2. Being enlightened in our inner person—Perfect tense: Having been enlightened (the moment we believed), so that we can see we are to grow in our understanding of God’s things through the Spirit, who increasingly fills our heart, soul and mind with the light of God’s Word, His wisdom that is in the Revelation of the Mystery.

--This wisdom is now being shined out of the darkness through Paul’s distinct apostleship (Acts 13:47—apart from Israel and through her fall) and into our believing hearts (2 Cor. 4:6) so that in seeing the perfect glory of God in the face of Jesus, we too are made into the “shiners” of His light/glory to others.

3. Putting it all together: The Holy Spirit fills our spirit with God's wisdom that comes from the revelation of the Mystery,
 - a. Which brings us into the full-knowledge of God and His things, which enlightens the eyes of our understand, our inner person,
 - b. Which moves outward, causing our face, our outer person, to "shine," radiating God's glory from the inside out.
 - c. Which is the fulfilling our sonship position with love and faith unfeigned (Rom. 12:9; 1 Tim. 1:3-5).
