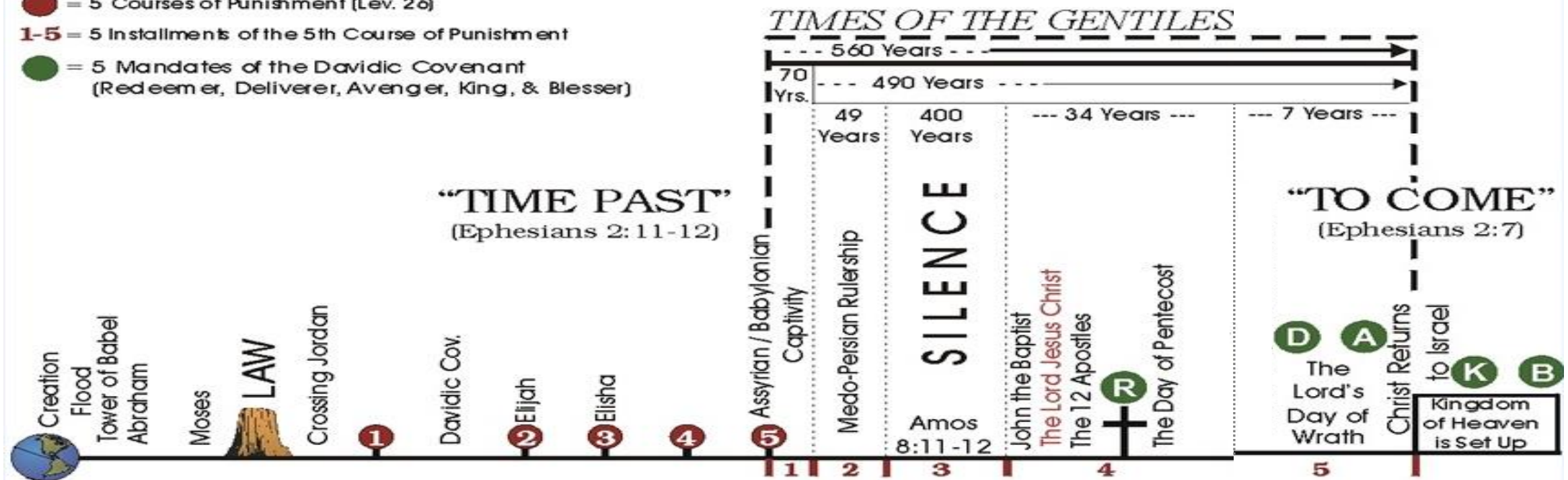

Three Things To Know

Pt. 2

1. Eph. 1:17-18a: Paul's Prayer Request--BACKWARDS:

That believers be enlightened (1:18a) ...

With the full-knowledge of God (1:17c) ...

That comes from the Spirit's Revelation of the Mystery (1:17b) ...

Which gives us the wisdom to operate in accord with His will
(1:17a).

2. Eph. 1:18b-23: Paul's Prayer Answer--BACKWARDS:

We need to know what is His exceeding great power toward us who believe whereby He re-organized the whole universe to make room for US-IN-CHRIST in the heavenly realm by putting old creation under His feet and US-IN-CHRIST under His Head, filling us with His fullness (1:19-23; Col. 1:18) ...

And know that He did this to make us into His showcase of glory, which is His inheritance in US-IN-CHRIST (1:18b) ...

And know that this is how He enables us to fulfill His calling for US-IN-CHRIST, giving us hope (1:18a).

3. The hope of His calling for us: There is only 1 hope of our calling—our station or role in God’s plan and purpose--today (Eph. 4:1-5) that provides hope and when God called us:
 - a. He placed us into the ONE Body of Christ (not the Nation of Israel)
 - b. We are called in ONE hope or our calling.
 - It is 100% certain because it does not depend on who we are and what we do but on who Christ is and what He did for us—by grace through faith (Rom. 5:1-2; Gal. 5:5).

- It comes from the riches of the glory of the Mystery (Col. 1:27; Rom. 15:13) and laid up for us in Heaven (Col. 1:5).
- It saves us from the despair of now of living in a groaning creation (Rom. 8:24), even breaking through death (1 Thess. 4:13) with eternal life (Titus 1:2; 3:7).
- It culminates at the appearing of the LJC in rapture (Titus 2:13| 1 Thess. 2:19).

c. As revealed in the ONE faith system for today that is revealed in the Revelation of the Mystery, not the Revelation of Prophecy)

d. Through the ONE baptism for today that places us in Christ (the HS baptizing us into Christ and His Body (Rom. 6:3-5; 1 Cor. 12:13). Not water baptism or Christ baptizing believing Israel with the Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 2:17, 38).

4. If these unities are not observed and appreciated:

a. There will be no unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Eph. 4:3).

b. And we won't walk worthy of our calling, serving in love (Eph. 4:1-2).

c. There is no other way.
