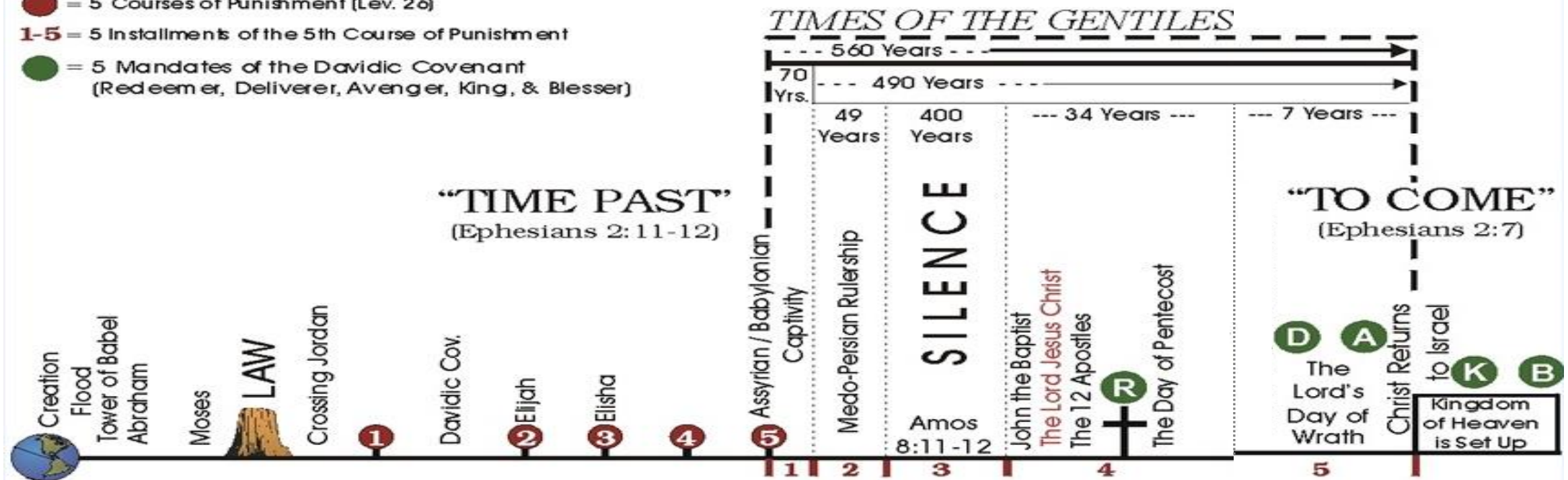

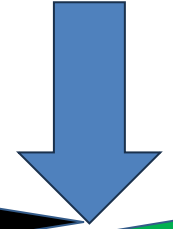

1. The foundation of mature Christian knowing:
  - a. Knowing what is the Hope of His Calling for us
    - He called us to be participants in HisMystery Program with Body of Christ to re-establish His Glory in the Heavens.

Once we know, understand and appreciate that ...

- b. We will know the Riches of the Glory of His inheritance in us
  - He makes US-IN-CHRIST, the Body of Christ, into the showcase of His Glory in the heavens.

Once we know, understand and appreciate that ...

- c. We will know that to accomplish all of this will require the exceeding greatness of His power, the Riches of His Power, toward us.
- It is the power God worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead, exalted Him through the hostile heavenly realm and seated Him in the Heavens at His Own right hand.
  - Thereby re-structuring creation to make room for the Body of Christ, putting the old creation under His feet (and our feet —Rom. 16:20???), and His new creation under His head where He is filling us with His fullness.
  - Fulfilling His calling for us to be the showcase of His Glory in the Heavens.

2. In Eph. 1:1-14 the “weakness” of Christ’s DEATH on the Cross provided redemption from sins (1:7, 14).
  - In Eph. 1:19-23 the power of His RESURRECTION provides life and victory now and forevermore, seated far above all powers in the Heavens in Christ (1 Cor. 6:14; Rom. 1:4; Phil. 3:10; Col. 2:12).
  
3. Isn’t it wonderful to know that God is for us (Rom. 8:31ff)?
  - a. God’s power in Christ toward us who believe (1:19).
  - b. Christ’s powerful rulership over all creation is exercised on behalf of the Church, the Body of Christ (1:22).

4. The exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe is described by piling up superlatives:
  - a. Exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, the working of His mighty power. Col. 1:11 adds all might and glorious power!
  - b. Human language cannot express the depth of God's power.
  - c. Perhaps RICHES OF THE RICHES OF THE RICHES OF THE RICHES HIS POWER toward believers!
  
5. The life-giving power available to believers today raised Christ from the dead (1:20) and is working in US-IN-CHRIST through the Holy Spirit and PGMT (3:5, 7), empowering us to proclaim God's Grace and display His manifold Wisdom (1:9-10).
