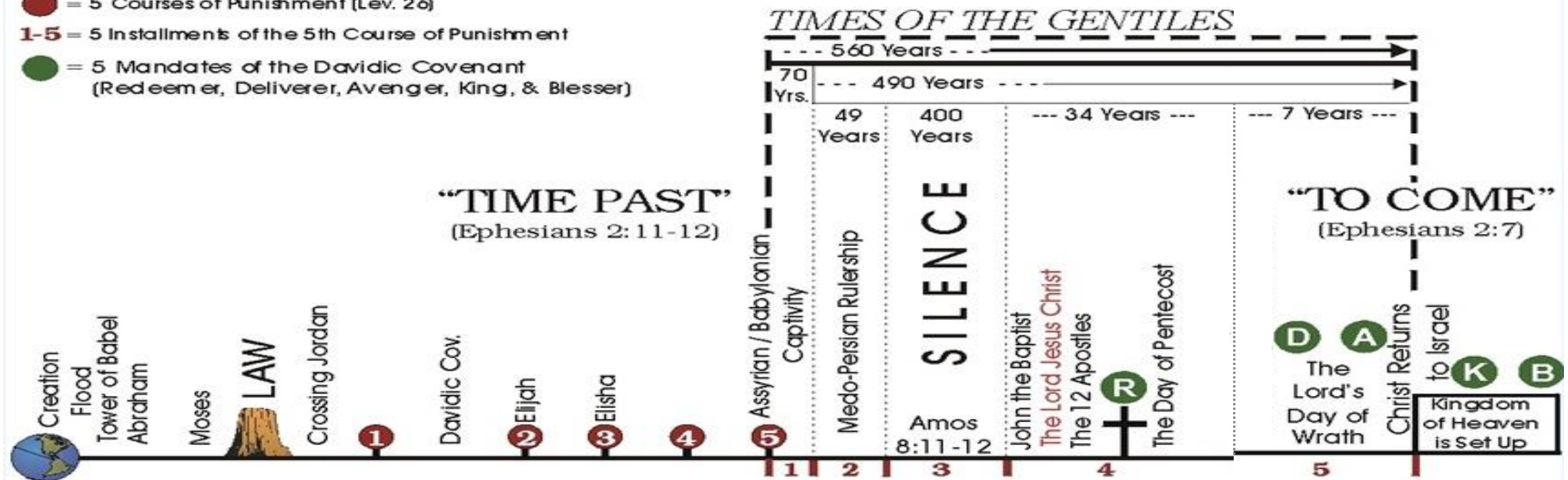

# The Power that Frees

Eph. 2:1-10

1. We can think about how God might use the Body of Christ to dispossess the hostile heavenly powers by looking at how He did it on earth through the Nation of Israel when they entered the Promised Land (Num. 32:20-22; 33:50-53).
  - a. Rev. 12:7-12—we something similar in the heavenly realm.
  - b. Eph. 6:10-13: we can already practice and participate in the reclamation of the heavenlies by putting on the armor of God, which is Pauline Grace Mystery Truth.
    - v. 10 IN THE LORD points back to Eph. 1:1-14.
    - v. 10b—IN THE POWER OF HIS MIGHT points back to Eph. 1:19-23.

## The Powers and the Powerless:

- A . Eph. 1:19-20: God's exceeding great POWER exemplified in the raising of Christ from the dead and seating Him at His right hand in the Heavens far above the created powers of:
- B . Eph. 1:21-23: The hostile angelic power levels that belonged to the old fallen creation were put under Christ's feet while His new creation, the Body of Christ, was put under His head and filled with His fullness.
- B'. Eph. 2:1-3: These hostile power levels--sin and death, the world and Satan, the flesh and self—rule over the powerless (Rom. 5:6) in rebellion against God and rejection of His Word, worthy of wrath and judgment.
- A'. Eph. 2:4-10: By Grace Through Faith: God's POWER levels did for the believer what they did for Jesus Christ (Eph. 1:19-20).



2. What His exceeding great power does for us (Eph. 1:19, 22-23):
  - a. Freed us from sin and death (Eph. 2:1) and brought us into righteousness and life (Rom. 3:23-24; 6:17-18).
  - b. Freed us from the evil course of this world so that we can walk according to God's good course (Rom. 12:2-3).
  - c. Freed us from the kingdom of Satan and Darkness—and placed us in the Kingdom of Christ and Light (Col. 1:11-14).
  - d. Freed us from the spirit (Satan) that now works in fallen humanity's dead spirit and gave us His Spirit, which now works in redeemed humanity's living spirit (Rom. 5:5; 8:1-11; Eph. 1:13, 17).

- e. Freed us from being in Adam where his disobedience became our disobedience to being in Christ where His obedience becomes our obedience of faith (Rom. 5:12-21).
- f. Freed us to serve God by serving others selflessly in Love and Righteousness, from hearts and minds enlightened with God's Truth rather than serving self and sin, selfishly satisfying the covetous desires of our own evil flesh with foolish and darkened hearts and minds (Rom. 1:18-32 cp. Eph. 1:17-18; Rom. 6:17-23; 12:1-10)
