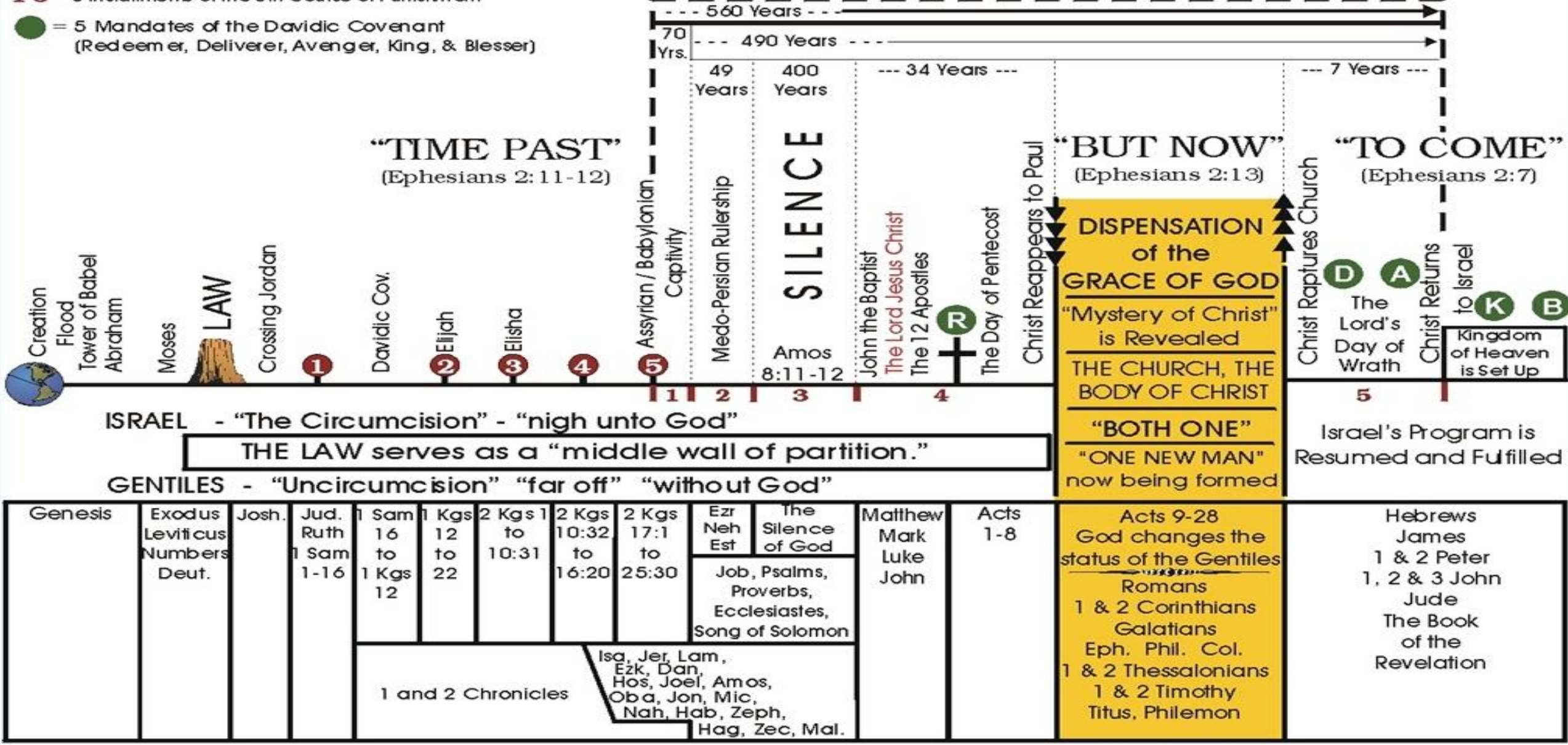
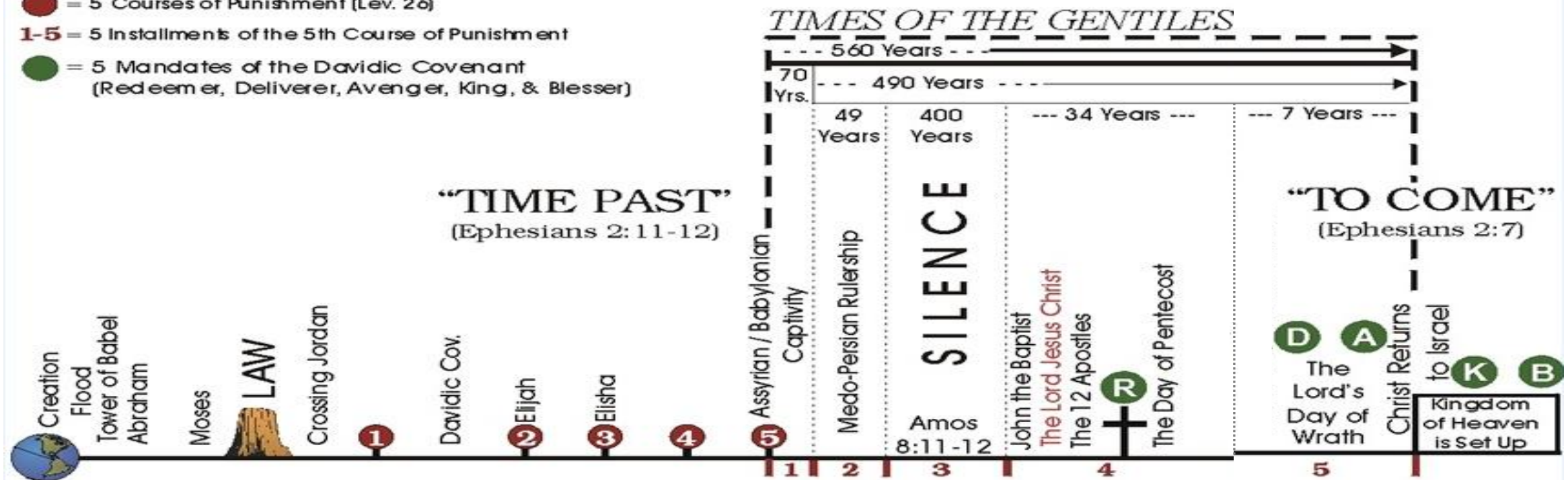

Riches of Grace/Facets of Faith

Eph. 2:5-8

# 1. GRACE AND FAITH FIREWORKS:

Grace and faith have been constant threads tying the fabric of Ephesians together.

## a. Grace

--Eph. 1:2—Grace and Peace to an enemy world that deserves His wrath and judgment (Mercy);

--Eph. 1:6—The praiseworthy glory of all that is true about His Grace that made us accepted before God in His Beloved Son, the Lord Jesus Christ;

--Eph. 1:7—According to the riches of His Grace made possible through His work on the Cross for us, He delivered us from the sphere of existence where everything was against us according to the riches of His Grace;

--Eph. 1:8-9—And from His riches of Grace brought us into a sphere of existence as revealed in the Mystery of His Will —the Revelation of the Mystery;

Just in Eph. 1, we go from:

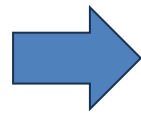


--Eph. 2:5, 8—Saved by Grace;

--Eph. 2:7—So that He can make us into the showcase of the exceeding riches of His Grace;

Grace

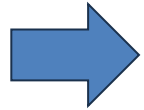

--Eph. 3:2—This is the Dispensation of Grace, dispensed and made known through the distinct apostleship of Paul;

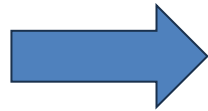


The Gift of Grace:

- Eph. 4:7—God gives us Grace according to the infinite measure of the gift of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ;
- Eph. 4:29—Therefore, we can afford to share it with others. heedlessly and with wild abandon, giving and dispensing it to others.

In Eph. 4 we go from:

b. Faith in its 4 facets:

- Eph. 1:1—Believers/saints are faithful ones, having obeyed God by believing (Our Faith) His truth through the Apostle Paul (The Faith) about the faithful work of Christ on the Cross for sinners (Faith of Christ).
- Eph. 1:13—This happened they heard the word of truth (The Faith) and believed (Our Faith), they were sealed with the Holy Spirit.
- Eph. 1:15—Because of their Faith (in The Faith about the Faith of Christ), Paul rejoiced.
- Eph. 1:19—God wants us to know the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe (in The Faith about the Faith of Christ) on the outside.

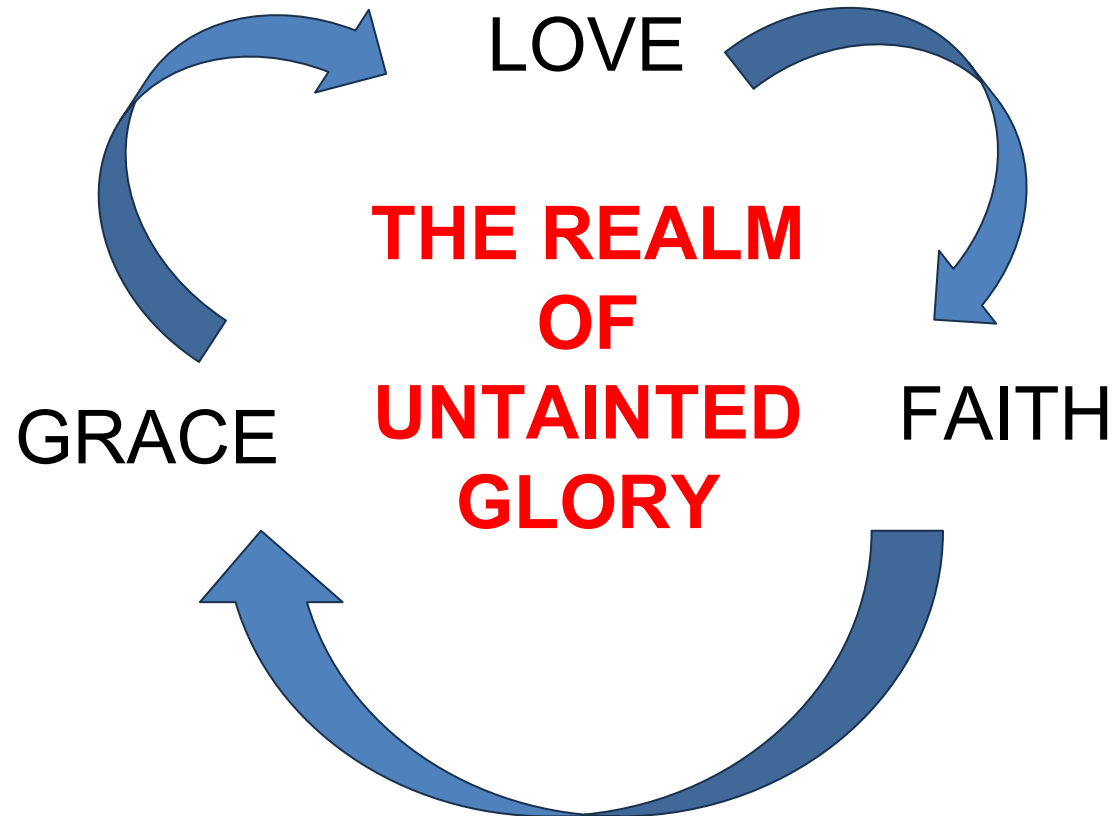
- Eph. 3:12—Believers have access to God in Christ through His faithful work on the Cross for them (Faith of Christ).
- Eph. 3:17--God wants us to know the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe (in The Faith about the Faith of Christ) on the inside;
- Eph. 4:5—After the Transition Period, there is now only 1 faith, 1 body of truth for today (The Faith—PGMT).
- Eph. 4:13—Being unified in this 1 faith (The Faith) brings us into the full-knowledge of Christ—The Faith, the preaching of Jesus Christ according to the Revelation of the Mystery (Rom. 16:25), the unsearchable Riches of Christ (Eph. 3:8)--is the only means of maturity that brings the Body of Christ into the measure of the dimensions of the fullness of Christ (Eph. 3:18; 1:23);

--Eph. 6:16-17—Faith in all its facets—Our Faith in the Faith of Christ as revealed in the Faith that equips us in all faithfulness --is the defensive shield that puts out all the fiery darts of the Wicked One, on the one hand, and is the offensive sword of the Spirit—the Word of God rightly-divided, rightly-handled, on the other hand.

--Eph. 6:21—The full of faith (in all its aspects), delivered this Letter of faith (in all its aspects) to the Ephesians.

## In Summary:

--Eph. 6:23-24—And this Love (toward others) with Faith and Grace with Love (toward Christ) motivates and empowers believers in the sphere of sincerity, purity, and glory of God —that is uncontaminated by Satan, sin and death.
