MATTHEW 2: THE STAR PROPHECY


- 1. Infallible Proof #1: The Royal Genealogy—Mat. 1:1-17**
 - Jesus met all the legal requirements to establish that He is not just in the line of those who could fulfill it. He is the One Who Will Fulfill it.**
- 2. Infallible Proof #2: The Miraculous Birth**
- 3. Infallible Proof #3: The Star Prophecy—Balak and Balaam.**
- 4. Numbers opens with the “numbering” of Israel for military service in preparation for war.**
 - a. The fulfillment of the Abrahamic Covenant was beginning to be fulfilled.**
 - b. God begins to bless those who bless Israel and curse those who curse Israel.**
 - c. God begins to reclaim the earth from the Adversary and establish the Kingdom of God/Heaven on the earth.**
 - d. Through Abraham’s multiplied seed through the promise line of Isaac—the nation Israel—Satan’s Kingdom will be destroyed and restored to man in accord with God’s Will.**


MATTHEW 2: THE STAR PROPHECY

- 5. Satan's nations are in the Promised Land. God is getting ready to take it back for Himself.
--God is preparing Israel to go into the land and destroy the enemies—Satan's nations.**

- 6. Then Israel rebelled against God in unbelief and wandered in the wilderness for 40 years (Num. 14-15)**

- 7. When we get to Balak and Balaam in Num. 22, we are near the end of the 40 years.**
 - a. God once again begins to prepare Israel for entrance into the land and conquering the enemy.**
 - b. He gives them war experience through victorious battles on the way to the Promised Land—the Canaanite (Num. 21:1-3); Amorites (Num. 21:21-24); Bashon (Num. 21:32-25).**

MATTHEW 2: THE STAR PROPHECY

- 8. Balak the King of Moab wants to destroy the Israelites and puts together a plan to oppose God's plan for Israel and bring the Abrahamic Covenant to ruin.**
 - a. He is going to summon the spiritual realm of Satan through Satan's renowned prophet in the east—Balaam.**
 - b. He wanted to get the gods/demons behind the Gentile nations to come together and form a confederacy against Israel.**
 - c. Balak's goal is to get Balaam to overturn the Abrahamic Covenant by initiating a "satanic covenant" whereby blessing would come by cursing Israel.**
- 9. While Moses rehearses the Law with this new generation in the Plains of Moab, Barak is in the hills of Moab conspiring to destroy them. (Num. 22:1-7).**
- 10. Balak tries to get Balaam (God's donkey) to curse all of Israel (Num. 22:41-23:12)
--will Balak repent and bless instead of curse Israel? No.**

MATTHEW 2: THE STAR PROPHECY

- 11. Balak tries to get Balaam (God's donkey) to curse a part of Israel (Num. 23:13-26)**
 - a. No amount of summoning the Satanic realm—sacrifices, enchantments, divinations--will result in Israel being cursed.**
 - b. Even Israel herself won't change God's mind about her.**
 - c. Will Balak repent and bless instead of curse Israel? No.**

- 12. Then God gives Balaam a prophetic picture of the future Israel in her Kingdom. (Num. 23:27-24:11)**
 - a. Balak and all other Gentile nations could participate in the glory of Israel's Kingdom.**
 - b. But they must bless Israel not curse her.**
 - c. Would Balak repent and bless Israel? No. He grew angry.**

- 13. Now God gives a prophetic picture of what happens to Gentile nations who persist in cursing Israel—a Day of Wrath. (Num. 24:14-25).**

--The destruction of Balak's confederacy (Balaam, Kenites, Moabites, Edom, Amalek, Ashur, Eber, etc.) is a prefigure of the complete destruction of Satan's Policy of Evil against Israel in the Tribulation Period.

MATTHEW 2: THE STAR PROPHECY

- 14. Paul explains that his apostleship is in accord with what God announced through Balaam—a. Rom. 11:1-6: Israel is God's separated people a distinct nation unto Himself. He is not done with them. He has not cast them away permanently.**
 - b. Rom. 11:28: God does not repent or lie regarding Israel. God's gifts to Israel are without repentance. Balak/Balaam tried to get God to change His mind about Israel. But He announced to the world then that He would NEVER EVER do that.**
 - c. Rom. 11:12: Israel's fulness and the fulfillment of the Abrahamic Covenant with its blessings for those who bless Israel and curses for those who curse Israel (and God) are absolutely certain.**
- 15. Having thrown away Paul's distinct apostleship, which resulted in the throwing away of National Israel's Prophetic Program, Historic Christianity is operating in accord with Balak and the false prophet Balaam.**

--If God is all done with national Israel in the physical land of Canaan, then the Satanic realm has tricked God into turning away from Israel and has broken His promises to her.
- 16. Without Paul's distinct apostleship, God is in fact unfaithful, unrighteous and a liar, unworthy of worship or blessing.**
