The Death and Resurrection of Christ

The resurrection of Christ is what separates Christianity from all man-made religious and theological systems of the world.

Christianity rises or falls on the basis of the resurrection. Without it everything, even the death of Christ itself, is worthless, it was all for nothing and we believers are of all people most miserable. (1 Cor. 15)

But this isn't the case! Christ arose
from the dead. (Lk. 24:1-12)

God's Prophecy Program and Christ's Resurrection: To re-
establish His Glory on earth. (Acts 2:30-31)

God's Mystery Program and Christ's Resurrection: To re-
establish His Glory in the heavenlies. (Eph. 1:19-2:10)

If there is no resurrection, there is no resurrection of Christ,
there is no resurrection of believers and all the benefits of His
death proclaimed by Paul vanish into thin air.

(1 Cor. 15:12-19)

THE GOOD NEWS OF THE DEATH OF CHRIST:

- a. Commends His Love to sinners and reconciles them to God. (Rom. 5:8-10; Gal. 2:20)
- b. Provides forgiveness of sins. (Rom. 3:25; Eph. 1:7-14)
- c. Provides the remedy to SIN. (Rom. 5:17-19)
- d. Makes alive the dead. (Eph. 2:1-7))
- e. Provides the basis for service to God. (2 Cor. 5:14-15)
- f. Identifies us with Christ unto newness of life. (Rom. 6:3-4)
- g. Provides for us to have the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus. (Rom. 8:2-3)
- h. Provides the basis for our resurrection. (Rom. 8:23)
- i. Sanctifies us, setting us apart for His purposes. (Rom. 6:4-8)
- j. Ensures our eternal security. (Rom. 8:31-39)

If God did not raise up Jesus from the dead, He isn't going to raise up anyone else from the dead, and He is not the "God who makes alive the dead. He ceases to be God!
(Rom. 4:17).
