JAMES 2

- 1. The key verse in James is 1:26 along with 2:20 and 4:4-5. James is countering the false teaching of apostate Israel's vain religious system (VRS—Is. 1:12-13) that will be especially intense during the Tribulation Period.
- 2. Two groups of people:
 - a. The synagogue—mix of believing and unbelieving Jews. (Jam. 2:2)
 - b. Assembly/church—believing Jews (Jam. 5:14)
- 3. One of the key characteristics of Israel's Vain Religious System was a wicked tongue.
 - a. Is. 3:8-9; 5:18-24
 - b. Prov. 17:4, 20
 - c. Ps. 109

JAMES 2

- 4. This is what Jesus warned about:
 - a. Mat. 7:15-23—You shall know them from their fruits (Jam. 2)
 - b. Mat. 12:22-37
- 5. The godly and vain tongue:
 - a. The godly tongue is used to steer people the right way to prevent wavering and stumbling. (3:1-5)
 - --The VRS uses the tongue for the purposes of iniquity, hell and Satan, destroying everything in its path. (3:6-8)
 - b. The godly tongue praises God and blesses His people.
 - --The VRS's tongue claims to praise God while cursing His people--IMPOSSIBLE. (Jam. 3:9-12)
 - c. The godly tongue is controlled by wisdom that speaks humility grace and peace. (Jam. 3:13-18)

JAMES 2

- 6. The meaning of trials: (1:2-12)
 - a. VRS—they indicate God's displeasure with you—you should panic and return to them.
 - b. James—they produce patience which leads to completeness. The only thing you need to return to is God through the prayer of faith.
 - -- They must not compromise with the VRS resulting in wavering.
 - --Instead endure temptation (to the end—Mat. 10:22; 24:13) and receive the crown of life.
