FAITH And God's Word: Right Division (Pt. 3)

Rom. 15:9-12



1. God gave us His Word—the Old Testament, Christ's earthly ministry and the ministry of the 12 in the Gospel Accounts, Acts and the General Epistles, and Paul's epistles--that we might learn things that will give us patience, encouragement and hope (15:4).

- 2. To accomplish this, Paul prays that God would give them Christ like-mindedness so that they can all be united in praising God with one mind and one mouth unto the GLORY OF GOD (15:5-6)!
 - --The participating in the GLORY OF GOD that we threw away as sinners in Rom. 1:23 we regain in Rom.15 when we GLORIFY God together and receive one another the way Christ received us—graciously and freely--unto the GLORY OF GOD (15:7).

 In order to do this, we must handle the whole Word of God correctly. What do we do with the hodge-podge of Scriptures? The Romans would have had:

 Christ's Earthly Ministry and the Ministry of Peter and the 12 confirm the promises God made Israel in His Prophetic Program, which had been spoken about since the world began (Rom. 15:8). 5. The FIRST thing we need to understand when it comes to handling God's complete Word correctly so that we can receive a God-given like-mindedness that will empower us to praise God together with one mind and one mouth (Rom. 15:4-7) is that Christ's earthly ministry and the ministry of Peter and the 12 are part of God's Prophetic Program with the Nation of Israel which had been spoken about since the world began (Rom. 15:8; Lk. 1:70 & Acts 3:21 cp. Rom. 16:25).

6. The SECOND thing we need to understand is that Gentiles in God's Prophetic program receive mercy and blessings WITH ISRAEL and THROUGH HER RISE.

- Rom. 15:9--David/Believing Israel would be saved and delivered and all enemies destroyed beginning in the House of Israel and esp. the Gentiles first.
 - --Then, after this, the believing David/Nation would be raised up above all other nations to sing God's praises and glorify God's Name to the Gentiles, inviting them to join in the singing (Ps. 18:49). WITH ISRAEL AND THROUGH HER RISE!

b. Rom. 15:10—Then, the Gentiles respond by accepting this invitation, singing along with Israel, rejoicing in the Lord together with His people Israel (Deut. 32:43). WITH ISRAEL AND THROUGH HER RISE! c. Rom. 15:11—Once Israel and the Gentiles are praising and worshipping the one true God together with Israel, then all peoples everywhere, Jews and Gentiles alike, will be rejoicing in the Lord (Ps. 117:1). WITH ISRAEL AND THROUGH HER RISE!

d. Rom. 15:12—And when that happens the whole world will turn to the Lord Jesus Christ, Israel's King and Messiah, to rule over them, to do with them what He did with Israel, trusting in Him, and being the recipients of His blessings in the earthly Kingdom of righteousness and peace (Is. 11:1-12). WITH ISRAEL AND THROUGH HER RISE!

- In God's Prophetic Program with Israel, therefore, the Gentiles have no hope of their own (Eph. 2), but they could participate in Israel's hope. This is fulfilled by:
 - a. God first blessing and showing mercy to believing Israel, restoring her as a nation in her land under her King, the Lord Jesus Christ, and then raising her above all other nations.
 - b. In doing this, God will have delivered His friends (believing Israel and those believing Gentiles associated with her) and destroyed all His enemies.
 - c. Then restored Israel will take God's mercy and blessings out to the rest of the world, the Gentiles, who will participate in God's things with Israel and through her RISE.

8. What a glorious program this is—Blessings going out the Gentiles and restoration of the whole earth is set in motion by the restoration and RISE of national Israel. Wonderful, amazing, awesome!

But there is one BIG

HUMUNGOUS INSURMOUNTABLE Problem

- Paul just told us in Rom. 9-11 that national Israel had stumbled and fallen and gone dark, and that God had cast them away, setting aside His Prophetic Program (temporarily)! (Rom. 11:11-12, 15; Acts 15:16).
 - --God's "conduit" of blessings to the Gentiles broke; His "hose" for dispensing His mercy to the Gentiles burst.
 - --Without national Israel, the OT provides no hope for the Gentiles, and neither does the earthly ministry of Christ or the ministry of Peter and the 12 in the Gospel Accounts, or Acts or the General Epistles because they continue from the OT.

- 10. If God had no other program than His Prophetic Program, the Gentiles are doubly, utterly, absolutely, hopeless because while they had no hope of their own they could participate in Israel's hope. But now that Israel had fallen and been set aside, they could not even participate in that!
 - --But the God of Hope did do something. He opened up a new conduit/hose of mercy to the world, esp. the Gentiles, through Paul's distinct apostleship (Rom. 15:13-20):
